Clerk Brown reviewed Profit and Loss v Actual report. All line items are in the black. The bills were reviewed. Brown presented correspondence received.

Deputy Supervisor and Treasurer Schmidtendorff reviewed Fire Board meeting. Mottville has accepted the White Pigeon contract and have signed an agreement for service for one year. The FEIS book for US 131 has been received and will be in the Township Office for review.

Supervisor Hutson reviewed the Zoning Commission decision to allow semi-tractors to park in R-1 zones. The ordinance will be enforced in approximately one month

The Monsanto-DeKalb IFT application has been received and there will be a public hearing at the June Township Board meeting.
