The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Hutson at 7:30 p.m.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Dan Riggs, Democratic candidate for St. Joseph County Sheriff, presented his credentials and experience in the area of Law Enforcement.

Hutson put forth the idea of a part time office employee for future consideration. The Board reviewed the County Road Commission's resolution regarding improvements made to gravel roads. The Board approved a letter written by Hutson to former attorney Craig Rolfe regarding his service to this Township and the best to him in his future endeavors. Hutson indicated he had received bids for sealing and /or repaving of the Cemetery roads. It appears that the roads are beyond sealing and will require repaving.
