

SUMMARY OF PLANTING & DECORATION RULES FOR
CONSTANTINE' TOWNSHIP CEMETERY

I: PROHIBITED AT ALL TIMES OF THE YEAR:

- 1) The planting or placement of bushes or trees anywhere in the cemetery.
- 2) Sand, gravel, washed gravel, crushed stone or other loose material.
- 3) Steps or artificial walkways of any kind.
- 4) Mounds raised around graves.
- 5) The alteration or removal of any sod or earth from any area in the cemetery.
- 6) The covering of lots with carpets, cloth or burlap. (Only leaves or evergreen boughs may be used to cover an area in the winter.)
- 7) Anything that hinders the free use of the lawn mower or other gardening apparatus.
- 8) The decoration of lots or graves with fencing, edging, boxes, toys, shells, wire screens, arbors, trellises, individual flowers anchored to the ground or any objects of a similar nature.
- 9) Glass or ceramic objects or containers of any kind.
- 10) Settees, benches or chairs.
- 11) Refuse of any kind, except that which is deposited in the provided receptacles.

H: URNS: Urns will be removed from lots if:

- 1) They are encroaching on adjacent grave, lots or isle ways.
- 2) They are in front of or behind a monument. (They must be placed to the side of a monument or marker.)
- 3) They are tipped over or not sufficient enough in weight to remain upright.
- 4) They are broken, unsightly, or a nuisance.
